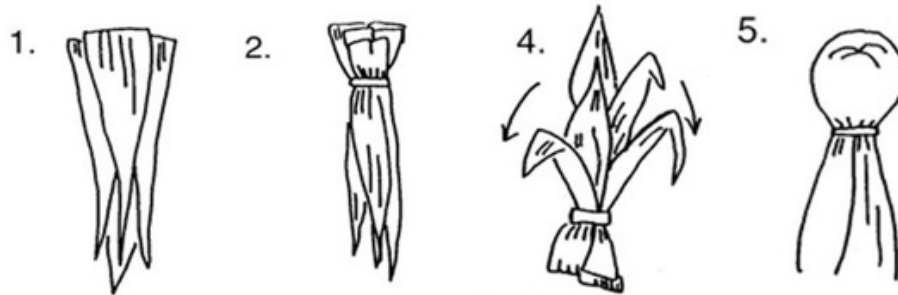
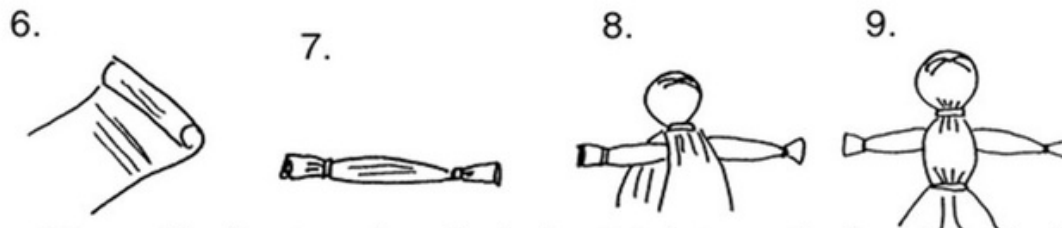


Seed to Fibre Textile Art Program & Morningstar Arts Creative STEAM S.M.A.R.T Lesson Plan



In steps 1-5 you will bundle four pieces of corn husk, tie a piece of corn husk at the top of the bundle and fold over the corn husk to make a face. (exclude Step 3. Use Scissors)



In steps 6-9 you will roll a piece of corn husk, place it in between the draped corn husk and tie the ends to make the arms. You will also tie a piece of corn husk around the waste to create the body
