Perhaps you are the Griot of your family or community!







2022 Telling Your Story Workshop Bookmark Pocket

Cut along dotted line and fold on solid lines

Cut your bookmark pocket along the dotted line. Fold the three flaps along the solid lines. Once the three flaps have been folded, place glue along your folded flaps and fold them back so the glued side will be facing your journal coverpage. Press into the journal cover page and let dry. When the glue is dry you are ready to decorate and use your pocket
